<b>Modifications:</b>	Moved the agency or department's recommendation from #4 to 3G because it only applies when the juvenile is placed out-of-home.
<b>Comments:</b>	<p><b>Note:</b> JD-1746T contains TPR Notice. TPR Notice should be provided for out-of-home cases and when a parent is denied periods of physical placement or visitation.</p> <p>RMC recommends that the court not rely upon attachments alone as the basis for its findings. Where attachments are used, specific reference to the document title, page and paragraph should be made.</p> <p>RMC has concerns that out-of-home placements ordered to be effective in the future may violate ASFA rules. One suggested procedure in these cases is to first enter a dispositional order placing the child at home, then revise the dispositional order pursuant to §938.363 upon the actual removal from the home. Another option is to adjourn the dispositional hearing until the actual removal date.</p>
