On July 3, 2013, the State Bar of Wisconsin, by its thenpresident, Kevin Klein, filed this rule petition asking the court to
amend Supreme Court Rules (SCRs) 10.03(3) and (5) relating to classes
of membership and membership dues and reduction of dues. The
petition seeks to modify membership status of State Bar members to
include a senior emeritus membership and active emeritus membership
and raise the age for emeritus membership to 75. In addition, the
proposed amendments grant a waiver of one-half dues to those members
admitted to practice five or fewer years, rather than three or fewer
years.
