On April 25, 2017, Attorney Steven Levine filed a petition asking the court to repeal and replace Supreme Court Rule (SCR) 10.03(5) (b) with SCR 10.03(5) (b)-(e) and to amend SCR 10.03(6) relating to mandatory State Bar dues.
