Waiver of Fees for Qualified Veterans

Greetings:

I am assisting the Wisconsin Supreme Court with its consideration of rule petition 13-02 filed by the Board of Bar Examiners (BBE). The petition was filed at the request of this court to implement the legislature's request that this court promulgate a rule waiving the initial admission fee for lawyers admitted to practice who are qualified veterans. See Wis. Stat. § 751.153. You have received this letter because you or your agency or organization has been identified as potentially having an interest in this matter. A copy of the petition can be found at the court's Web site at http://wicourts.gov/scrules/pending.htm.

The court discussed this petition at an open rules conference on February 28, 2013. On February 26, 2013, the Department of Veterans Affairs sent a letter to the court requesting that the court include the waiver of the bar examination fee for qualified veterans. The court voted unanimously to adopt the petition with the modification to include waiver of the bar examination fee for qualified veterans. The court wanted to ensure that as many veterans as possible could benefit from this new rule. Therefore, the rule change is effective immediately and will also apply to all pending qualified applicants for the July 2013 bar exam. A copy of the Department of Veterans Affairs' February 26 letter is also on the court's Web site at http://wicourts.gov/scrules/pending.htm.

Mindful of its commitment to encouraging public participation in the rules process, the court voted to solicit public comment on the new rule. All comments will become part of the public file in this matter and may be considered by the court at a future open rules conference.

Your comment, if any, to the rule petition should be filed by July 19, 2013, with the Clerk of Supreme Court, Attention: Deputy Clerk-Rules, P.O. Box 1688, Madison, WI 53701-1688.
