Re: Rule Petition 13-05, <u>Petition to Create Procedure for Enforcement of Supreme Court</u>

Disciplinary Orders

Dear Petitioners:

I am assisting the Wisconsin Supreme Court with its consideration of your rule petition requesting the court create a procedure for enforcement of its disciplinary orders (Rule Petition No. 13-05), which you filed on May 29, 2013. The court briefly discussed this petition in open rules conference on June 11, 2013, and has requested that I seek additional information about your request. The court requested more specific information about how this proposal would work in practice. Your response to the following issues or questions is sought at this time:

- How do other states enforce disciplinary orders?
- How does the OLR currently handle issues arising relating to enforcement of disciplinary orders?
- How often do you anticipate the OLR would need to invoke the proposed rule?
- Proposed SCR 22.18m provides for the filing of a "motion for contempt or enforcement." When might a motion for contempt be appropriate? When would a motion for enforcement be appropriate?
- Should such a motion be verified and/or supported by affidavit?
- Does the petition contemplate enforcement of all kinds of disciplinary orders or only orders imposing a financial obligation such as fees, costs, or restitution? In particular, should the proposal encompass enforcement of a lawyer's failure to comply with an order imposing conditions related to medical issues, mental health, substance abuse, and/or addiction-related matters?
- How does this proposal relate to SCR 21.16(2m)(c)?
- Would this proposal be used to assist private victims of attorney misconduct who have been unable collect court ordered restitution?

- Whether the amendments will have retroactive application?
- Comments from the Legislative Reference Bureau were previously provided by email on June 3, 2013. Keith Sellen responded by e-mail on June 3, 2013, on behalf of the OLR. The joint petitioners are asked to please respond to the comments with any amendments they deem necessary. If there are no additional comments, please state that fact. Thank you.

Please file your response(s) by September 30, 2013, with the Clerk of Supreme Court, Attention: Carrie Janto, Deputy Clerk, P.O. Box 1688, Madison, WI 53701-1688. If possible, e-mail a Microsoft Word version of the response(s) to carrie.janto@wicourts.gov or clerk@wicourts.gov.

The court may request further information prior to a public hearing or open rules conference. The court has scheduled this rule petition for a public hearing on Friday, October 25, 2013, at 9:30 a.m., in the Supreme Court Room in the State Capitol, Madison, Wisconsin, to discuss this matter. The court may take any action it deems appropriate, including any of the following:

- (a) Adopt the rule proposed, or a modified version, without further comment.
- (b) Reject the rule proposed without further comment.
- (c) Circulate the rule petition for comment without a public hearing.
- (d) Refer the rule petition to another entity for its review and recommendation.
- (e) Request further information or analysis from the petitioner or interested persons or entities.
